

COOKIES POLICY

LAST UPDATED ON THE 7th OF JUNE, 2018

In accordance with the provisions of article 22.2 of Law 34/2002 of the 11th of July on Services of the Information Society and E-commerce, ITAR World Investment S.L., the holder and owner of the website <http://www.bristolsunsetbeach.com/>, hereby informs you in this section of its policy for collecting and processing first-party and third-party cookies for the purposes of analysis, personalisation, marketing and technical matters on the aforementioned website.

Cookies are small text files that websites store in the browser of users visiting the website in order to make the user experience more efficient.

This website uses first-party and third-party cookies to personalise content and ads, offer social media functions and analyse traffic. In addition, we share information on how you use the website with our social media, advertising and web analysis partners, who can combine this with other information that they have been provided with or that they have collected based on your use of their services.

Some cookies are essential in order for the website to work, as in the case of the built-in search function. Others are used to collect information for statistical purposes and those related to website usage.

By using this website, you accept the use of cookies for the purposes and uses mentioned in the present Cookies Policy.

COOKIE USE BASED ON MANAGEMENT AND TIME ACTIVE

This website uses third-party services to collect information for statistical purposes and those related to website usage. Specifically, these consist of first-party cookies, third-party cookies, session cookies and active cookies for the purposes of analysis, personalisation, marketing and technical matters.

The following information on the types of cookies that this website contains may help you to better understand the functions that they make possible:

1. Based on the time that they remain in your browser

1.1 Session cookies. Session cookies are temporary cookies that remain in your device's cookies folder until your browser is closed, which means that none of them are stored on your hard drive. The information obtained by these cookies is used to make it possible to manage each of the users that is simultaneously accessing the website.

1.2 Persistent cookies. These are cookies that remain stored in the cookies folder of your device after your browser has been closed. The next time you visit the particular website, these cookies will inform the website and pull up information facilitating navigation (allowing users to directly access the service without having to go through the login process) or providing a commercial service (offering products or services related to past visits).

2. In addition, the cookies exchanged when browsing on a website can be:

2.1 First-party cookies. These are cookies that are generated by the website that you are visiting.

2.2 Third-party cookies. These are cookies that are received when browsing on this website, but which have been generated by a third-party service that is hosted on it. One example can be the cookies used by an ad or banner found on a website that you are visiting. Another is the cookie used by a user tracker employed by the website you are visiting.

3. Based on their purpose

In terms of their purpose, we use analytical, personalisation, marketing and technical (or necessary) cookies:

3.1 Necessary cookies. These allow a user to browse a website, platform or application and to use the various options or services that exist on it, such as controlling traffic and the transfer of data, identifying a session, accessing restricted areas, remembering the items that make up an order, carrying out the purchasing process for an order, making a request to sign up for or participate in an event, using security elements during browsing, storing content for the playback of videos or sound, or sharing content on social media.

3.2 Marketing cookies. Marketing cookies are used to track website visitors. Their purpose is to show ads that are relevant and appealing for the individual user and therefore more valuable to website publishers and third-party advertisers.
